ARTICLE 1 – INTRODUCTION

L'Étape Regional By Tour de France is an amateur cycling event designed to bring participants closer to the experience of the world's most prestigious cycling competition, the Tour de France.

The event aims to deliver high-level sporting entertainment while promoting tourism, local culture, and economic development in host cities.

These regulations define participation rules to ensure safety, fairness, and sportsmanship among all participants, staff, and spectators.

ARTICLE 2 – REGISTRATION

Registrations must be completed exclusively through the official website:

www.letapebrasil.com.br

- Entries are personal and non-transferable
- Registration implies full acceptance of these regulations
- Age group is determined by age on December 31 of the event year

Special Conditions

- Minors: only with notarized parental authorization
- Seniors (60+) and PCD: eligible for 50% discount upon validation

Incorrect registration information results in **disqualification**.

ARTICLE 3 – KIT PICK-UP

Kits must be collected at the **Event Village** on scheduled dates.

Kit Includes:

- Race number and timing chip
- Bike plate and stickers
- Official cycling jersey

Required Documents:

- Medical certificate (issued within 1 year)
- Official photo ID

Failure to present required documents prevents participation.

Kit transfer or misuse results in **disqualification and suspension**.

ARTICLE 4 – START PROCEDURES

Participants are assigned to **start groups (pelotons)**.

- Starting ahead of assigned group → **automatic disqualification**
- Starting behind → allowed

Assignments are based on:

- Previous results
 - Registration data

ARTICLE 5 – MANDATORY EQUIPMENT

Participants must use:

- Properly maintained bicycle powered only by human force
- Certified, fastened helmet

Bike Limits:

- Max length: 2.10 m
- Max width: 0.75 m

Only one bike allowed (except mechanical failure cases).

ARTICLE 6 – PROHIBITED EQUIPMENT

Not allowed:

- Electric or motor-assisted bikes
 - Recumbent bikes
 - Aerodynamic extensions (clip-ons, bar ends)
 - Disc wheels or aerodynamic covers

ARTICLE 7 – COURSE SAFETY

Participants must:

- Ride on the right side of the road
- Overtake on the left
- Follow signage and staff instructions

Violations (e.g., riding against traffic) result in **disqualification**.

ARTICLE 8 – TIME LIMITS

Participants must comply with official **cut-off times**.

Failure results in:

- Disqualification
- Removal via sweep vehicle

Ignoring staff instructions leads to:

- Loss of insurance coverage
 - Possible suspension

ARTICLE 9 – TIMING, RESULTS AND AWARDS

Timing is performed via **electronic chip system**.

Awards:

- Top 3 overall (male & female)
- Top 3 per age group

Categories:

Defined by age on December 31.

Special Titles:

- King of the Mountain
 - Queen of the Mountain

ARTICLE 10 – GENERAL RULES AND PENALTIES

Prohibited:

- Motorized support
- Drafting behind vehicles
- Pacing
- External assistance

Participants must:

- Follow the official course
- Not interfere with others

Unsportsmanlike conduct results in **disqualification**.

ARTICLE 11 – ENVIRONMENT

- Littering is strictly prohibited
- Waste must be disposed in designated areas

Violations may result in **penalties**.

ARTICLE 12 – ANTI-DOPING

The event complies with:

- Brazilian Cycling Confederation (CBC)
- World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA)

Athletes must:

- Know and follow anti-doping rules

Suspended athletes are not allowed to participate.

ARTICLE 13 – REGISTRATION CHANGES

Changes allowed under conditions:

Course Change

- Up to 15 days: R\$ 90
- Less than 14 days: R\$ 120

Peloton Change

- Subject to analysis and availability

Jersey Size

- Up to 30 days before event

ARTICLE 14 – TRANSFER AND CANCELLATION

Transfers

- Between athletes or events
- Fees: R\$ 200 – R\$ 250

Rules:

- Only one transfer allowed
- No refund after transfer

Cancellation

- Up to 1 day before event
 - Refund: 30%
-

ARTICLE 15 – INSURANCE

Coverage includes:

- Medical expenses up to **R\$ 40,000**

Emergency assistance provided.

Additional costs are the participant's responsibility.

ARTICLE 16 – IMAGE RIGHTS

Participants authorize:

- Use of name, image, voice, and performance
 - For global, commercial, and promotional purposes
 - Without compensation

ARTICLE 17 – CLAIMS AND APPEALS

- On-site claims: within **30 minutes**
- Formal appeals: within **30 days**

Fee: **R\$ 180**

No phone or informal requests accepted.
